LUNCH DELIVERIES	Students are reminded that lunch deliveries from delivery services such as Lyft and Uber Eats are not allowed at lunchtime or any other time during the day. Lunch deliveries will be confiscated and held in the main office until the end of the school day. Deliveries are a safety concern for everyone. Parents may only deliver lunches in person and must deliver the meal to the main office prior to the start of lunch. Students are not permitted beyond the 100 building during the lunch period to pick up food. Administration.
STUDENTS WITH ASSIGNED TIME HOME (ATH)	 Having ATH is a privilege and allows you to stay at home either first period or sixth period. We know that sometimes ATH students must be on campus during their designated period due to transportation. If you must be on campus during your ATH period these are the rules: During your Assigned Time Home Period you must remain in the Library. Once you come on campus you may not leave campus (no going back and forth off campus). You are not permitted to be in any teacher's classroom during your ATH (you must be in the library). You may not wonder around campus or hang out in the quad (you must be in the library).
